Being pregnant is a very exciting time in a woman’s life and WindRose Health Network (WHN) wants to help you make the best decisions about the prenatal care you and your baby receive. One of the first and most important decisions you will make is selecting a Physician Group & Hospital to deliver your baby as **WHN’s doctors will NOT be performing your delivery**. WHN works in partnership with (3) Physician Groups & (3) Hospitals to provide full-scope obstetrical care. However, the course of treatment and scope of care that you receive at WHN could be different depending on which option you choose.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ One of WHN’s (3) Prenatal Care providers at WHN-Epler Parke will see you for your prenatal care from approx. 10 weeks to 36 weeks gestation. Our providers rotate patients, so you will not necessarily see the same provider for each visit. ❖ WHN’s staff will schedule an ultrasound at Southside OBGYN or Franciscan St. Francis Hospital based on your weeks of gestation and schedule openings. ❖ At 36 weeks gestation, you will be transferred to Southside OBGYN for the remainder of your prenatal care and the delivery of your baby will occur at Franciscan St. Francis Health. ❖ After your baby is born, you will be scheduled with a WHN provider for your 6 week postpartum appointment at WHN-Epler Parke. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ One of WHN’s (3) Prenatal Care providers at WHN-Epler Parke will see you for your prenatal care from approx. 10 weeks to 40 weeks gestation. Our providers rotate patients, so you will not necessarily see the same provider for each visit. ❖ WHN’s staff will schedule an ultrasound at WHN-Epler Parke OR an IU Methodist Health Facility based on your weeks of gestation and schedule openings. ❖ The delivery of your baby will be performed at IU Methodist Hospital by an IU Family Medicine physician - - but not one of the providers from WHN-Epler Parke. ❖ After your baby is born, you will be scheduled with a WHN provider for your 6 week postpartum appointment at WHN-Epler Parke. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Dr. Abhigyan Banka at WHN-Franklin will see you for your prenatal care from approx. 10 weeks to 36 weeks gestation. ❖ WHN’s staff will schedule an ultrasound at Johnson County Women’s Care Group based on your weeks of gestation and schedule openings. ❖ At 36 weeks gestation, you will be transferred to Johnson County Women’s Care Group for the remainder of your prenatal care and the delivery of your baby will occur at Johnson Memorial Hospital. ❖ After your baby is born, you will be scheduled with Dr. Banka at WHN-Franklin for your 6 week postpartum appointment.

Medicaid Selection - If you have Medicaid and you want your pregnancy to be fully covered, you will need to choose a MCE (Managed Care Entity) that works with the Physician Group / Hospital that you wish to deliver with. No Insurance - If you are uninsured, WHN offers a sliding fee discount based on your household income for services provided by WHN providers at WHN-Epler Parke or WHN-Franklin. Additionally, depending on which Physician Group / Hospital you choose, we can provide approximate costs associated with your non-WHN-provided prenatal care, ultrasound and delivery. However, please realize this is an estimation and additional charges may occur.
